Basis of award will be determined by evaluating quotes from responsible contractors that provide the best value to the government as determined by the Contracting Officer, in terms of meeting the required product characteristics and price.

Offers in response to this solicitation must be submitted for all the requirements identified in the solicitation. Offers submitted for less than all the requirements called for by this solicitation may be rejected or ineligible for award.

This requirement is 100% set aside for small businesses under NAICS 315990, Business Size: 600 employees.

The Government intends to evaluate offers and award a contract without discussion. Therefore, vendors' initial offers should contain the best terms from a price and technical standpoint. However, the Government reserves the right to conduct discussions if later determined by the Contracting Officer to be necessary.

Submission Instructions:

Technical Specifications: All quotes for attached equipment items must include technical specifications, include product literature descriptions, manufacturer names and part numbers.

Price: The resulting award will be a Firm Fixed Price. Price reasonableness may be utilized in the evaluation of the Firm-Fixed Price effort. The Government shall employ price analysis techniques in accordance with FAR 13.106-3 to determine that a proposed price is fair and reasonable.
